Trainings are carried out in accordance with the "Training the Trainer Course Program (45 hours duration)", numbered 108, dated 2013-07-31, determined by the Board of Education and Discipline of the Ministry of National Education.

6. Officially recognised ways of acquiring the certificate

Evaluation will be done in three stages:

50% Written exam (to be applied in the classroom setting). 30% Product file (participants will need to prepare a product file containing the lesson plan, teaching materials, assessment tools and teaching techniques they will use. These product files will be evaluated by all faculty members contributing to the program and detailed feedback will be given to each participant about the product file). 20% Micro-teaching (After the completion of all modules of the program, each participant will make a presentation that lasts for a maximum of 10 minutes, after which the presentation will be evaluated and comprehensive feedback will be given by all faculty members and participants who contributed to the program).

"Certificate"; Those who fall below this rate are given a "Certificate of Participation".

In order to take the certification exam, it is required to attend at least 75% of each course in the program.
